

## STUDY QUESTIONS

### *Walk the Path – Knowing God*

This week, Scott Brizius, one of CFC's elders, will deliver a message focused on knowing God. This is the second sermon in our series *Walk the Path*. This series introduces our new Discipleship Pathway. He'll interact with Scripture from both the Old and New Testaments, related to the idea of knowing God.

1. Consider Romans 1:20. How does creation itself introduce us to the creator? This passage is usually aimed at non-Christians, but what might it have to say to those of us who do know God?
2. Think about 2 Timothy 3:16. This tends to be one of the first places we go in Scripture when talking about inspiration or God's active role in the authorship of the Bible. Think about the significance of a book written by our Creator about His nature and character as well as the lengths He has gone to in order to reconcile us to Himself. What does this mean for us and how we approach the Bible? Are there changes we might need to make in how we use our time to allow space for us to read and interact with God's Word on a more regular basis?
3. Read Deuteronomy 12:17. This was part of God's commands to the Israelites as He instructed them on how to remain faithful to Him in the midst of people who did not follow Him. What might we today learn from this passage as we think about the role of God's Word in our own lives?
