Read Acts 1:1-5

1. Dale has named this sermon series 'Praxis'. What does that term mean in relation to the book of Acts?
2. Who does the first half of the book of Acts highlight as the leader of the early church in Jerusalem? Who spearheads the spread of the gospel in the 2nd half of Acts?
3. What is a Bible times apostle? Which of the 4 gospels were written by apostles? Are we apostles today? Or disciples?
4. How do we know that Luke and Acts were written by Luke? Who was his audience? What were his purposes in writing these books?
5. Discuss the historical events surrounding the time in which Luke wrote Acts. (hints: Before or after the Roman fire, persecution, destruction of the temple)
6. What do we learn about Jesus from Acts 1:1-5? What can we learn about ourselves from this passage?
