Read Acts 12:20-25 and Daniel 4:27-37

1. Looking at the lives of Herod Agrippa and Nebuchadnezzar, what are the only apparent results of a fight with God?
2. How would you react if you "clicked" on an application icon and it didn't take you anywhere? In other words, what happens when icons want all the attention? (Answer: They stop being icons and become idols.)
3. What icons do you need to get rid of that you don't use anymore? What icons do you tend to fixate on and why.
4. To put it another way, why is less better than more when relating to the icons of our lives? The thought here is that some of us tend to crowd more in than we should, and we need take regular time to evaluate and purge. Same with our schedules and even more important our spiritual lives. Take a few minutes to think about how this relates to the way humans are created.
