2. Luke makes it clear that the Roman Governor, Sergius Paulus, was an intelligent man.
 - What does this say about the way we come to faith in the Lord Jesus?
 - What does the way that Luke described the geographical progression of this endeavor say about the validity of the historical events?
3. Consider this: *You don't surrender your brain when you give your heart to Jesus.* How do you react to this?
